


The 2012 Olympic Games are around the corner, so we have designed a fun synthetic phonics game to get into the Olympic team spirit!




- 1. Put children in pairs
- 2. Print out the medal templates and picture clue card (unit 2 has been prepared for you), duplicate this so each pair of children has a set
- 3. Cut out the medals and cut along the jigsaw lines
- 4. Mix all medal puzzle pieces up
- 5. Give each pair a set of medal puzzle pieces and picture cards
- 6. Each pair solves the puzzle by recreating the words with the pieces

For an extra challenge, why not have the children see if they can win gold in spelling?

- 1. Print out blank medals and hand them out to each pair
- 2. Have them come up with three words which use the target phonemes and write them on the medals, making sure one phoneme is each of the three jigsaw pieces, e.g. c/a/t or t/oa/d
- 3. Then, they can cut out each medal along the jigsaw lines and give their puzzle to classmates to solve!
