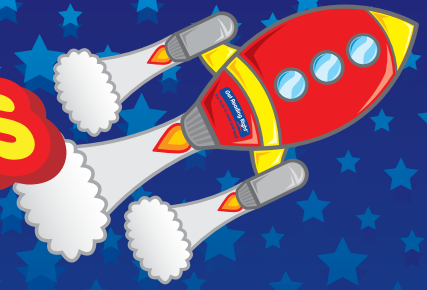

Shirley Houston

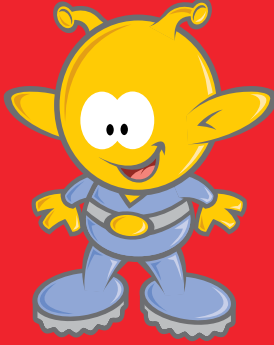

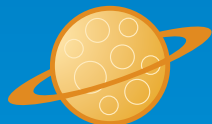
